As a club, we will be throwing a substantial amount of effort into the promotion of this event and as a starting point, we have secured (date pending) the attendance and support of two very very high profile Lawn Bowlers.
- To assist with the promotion of Jack Attack BGC, **Karen Murphy** (World Women's Singles Champion) and **Steve Glasson** (Previous Men's World number 1 and Current Australian Lawn Bowls Coach) will both be at BGC to help get things rolling (pun intended)! AUSTRALIA

Players are being encouraged to ensure their bowls are compliant with the standards set by the Laws of the Sport, following reports from independent bowls testers that the number failing to comply is on the rise.

Competitive bowlers are being urged to get their bowls checked regularly, as often as every five years, as wear on the running surface of the bowl can straighten the run of the bowl over time, possibly causing the bias to become non-compliant simply through wear.

The wearing of the bias is particularly prevalent in the modern narrower sets of bowls, given there is very little margin to the legal bias.

Bowls also fail to comply when all four bowls in a set are not matched to draw in a group within a five-centimetre radius on a testing table.

Australia's two independent bowls testing operators, Barry Cox from 'The Bowls Doctor' in Queensland, and Greg Sherman from 'The Bowling Arm' in Victoria, have noted the rise in the number of sets failing to comply with the standards set within the Laws of the Sport.

According to the latest testing results from Cox and Sherman of a total of 388 sets of bowls, an average of half have failed to adhere to the World Bowls standard required to be approved for competition.

"For those sets that don't comply, Barry and Greg are then able to rectify the bowls and re-stamp each bowl with a registered World Bowls Stamp, which under the Laws Of The Sport Of Bowls, authorises the bowls to be used in all games."

Each tester in the world, which includes six Australian-based organisations, has a testing table to ensure the correct weight and line, and is provided a master bowl by the World Bowls Board, which no individual bowl can draw less than.

The World Bowls master bowl is run down the table first, followed by the other four bowls that are being tested, which must all draw to at least the master bowl, not less than it, and must fall within a five-centimetre radius of the last bowl when drawn as a full set.

A licensed World Bowls Tester can test, repair and refurbish sets of bowls, and applies the World Bowls Stamp to validate that the bowl/s complies with all regulations and specifications of World Bowls.

Would you like to see more golf/bowls combined days such as 9 holes of golf and 12 ends of bowls? Excellent response 62.69% answered 'Yes'.

What is your favourite competition and should be played more often? Response: Triples 29.41% Fours 13.73% Pairs 11.76% Jackpot Skins 11.76%.

Would you play competition bowls on days we currently do not conduct competitions, if yes, which days? Response: Tues. 15.63% Wed. 34.38% Fri. (off season) 34.38% Sat. (off season) 43.75% Sun. (off season) 31.25%.

Do you play competition bowls at nearby clubs even though we host our own competitions on the same day? Yes 21.57% No 78.43%.

If you answered 'yes' to the above, what is your reason for doing so? Better prize money 20% Better facilities 6.67% Better location to home 13.33% I have friends at the club 33.33% Better facility/greens 6.67%.

Please rate the speed of the greens over the past 12 months. A bit too slow 6.52% Just right 84.78% A bit too fast 8.70%

Would you like to see more Bowls Information nights? Yes 57.45% No 42.55%

If you answered 'yes' to the above question, how often? Monthly 13.33% Twice annually 26.67% Quarterly 50% Annually 10%

Would you be interested in Bowls coaching? Yes 39.13% No 36.96% Most Common 'Other Comments' suggestions for higher level of coach for better players.

Q66. Do you understand the current Australian Bowls rules & regulations?

Not at all 6.12% In part, but I need to know more 32.65% To a satisfactory level 51.02% I know them in detail 10.20%
