Grade 5/6 Coolamatong Camp:


Water Posters


Sounds-Write - Free Resources (Foundation & Grade 1 Parents only)

Over the past three years, Buchan Primary School has been using Sounds-Write as our Systematic Synthetic Phonics Program (SSP). All F-1 students participate in a 25-minute session 5 times per week as part of their 2 hour literacy block. All staff, including Education Support staff, have completed a minimum six-week (38-hour) professional learning course to deliver the program to a high standard. In addition, Moira has completed the Sounds-Write Intervention (tutoring) course and published decodable readers for the company, while Aidan has completed the Phonics Masterclass & Coaching course. We are proud to share that this approach has delivered excellent results for our students. Sounds-Write has now developed practical strategies for supporting early reading and writing at home, using a structured, easy-to-follow approach. No prior training required: just short, accessible sessions that fit around everyday home routines. This is aimed at Foundation/Grade 1 parents only.




