Parent Teacher Interviews

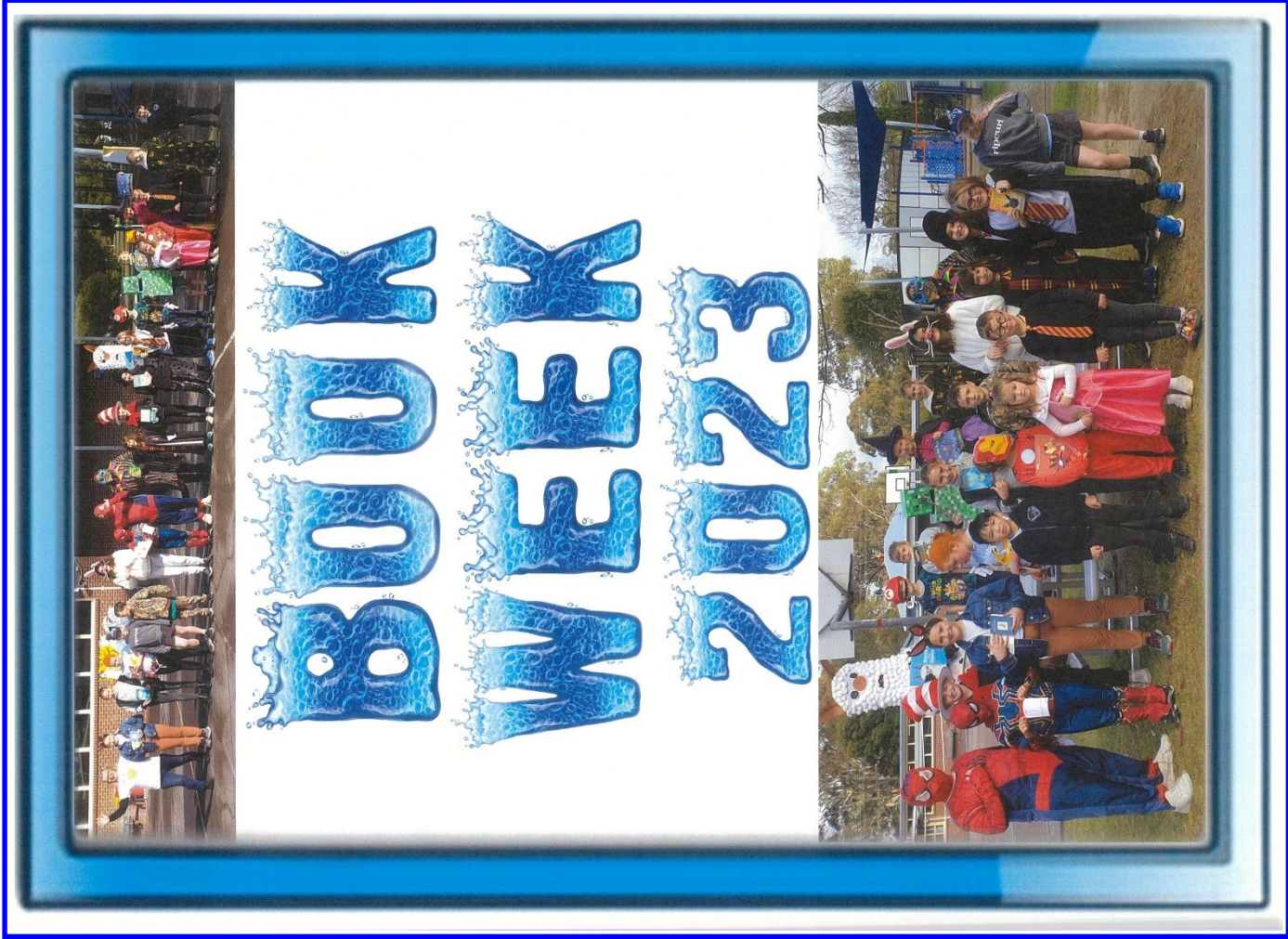
