They had a slip and slide and a lake with a pool attached to it. I was in cabin seven with a really fun leader.

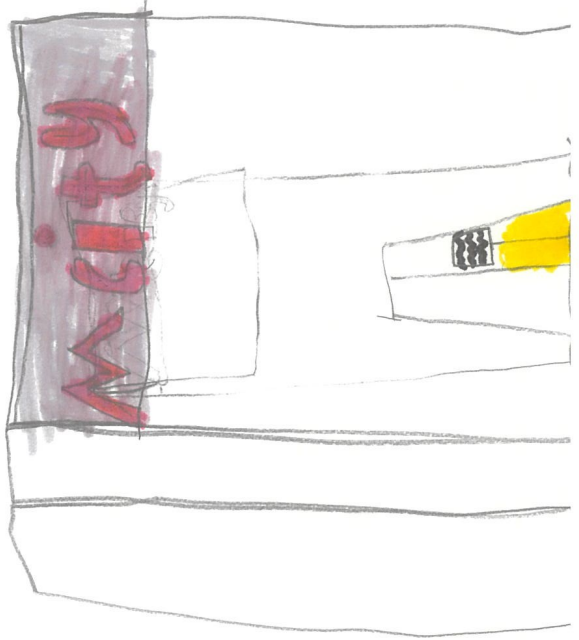
Cabin 6 and 8 were next to us and they were fun cabins. My cabin leader was Ben, he was fun.

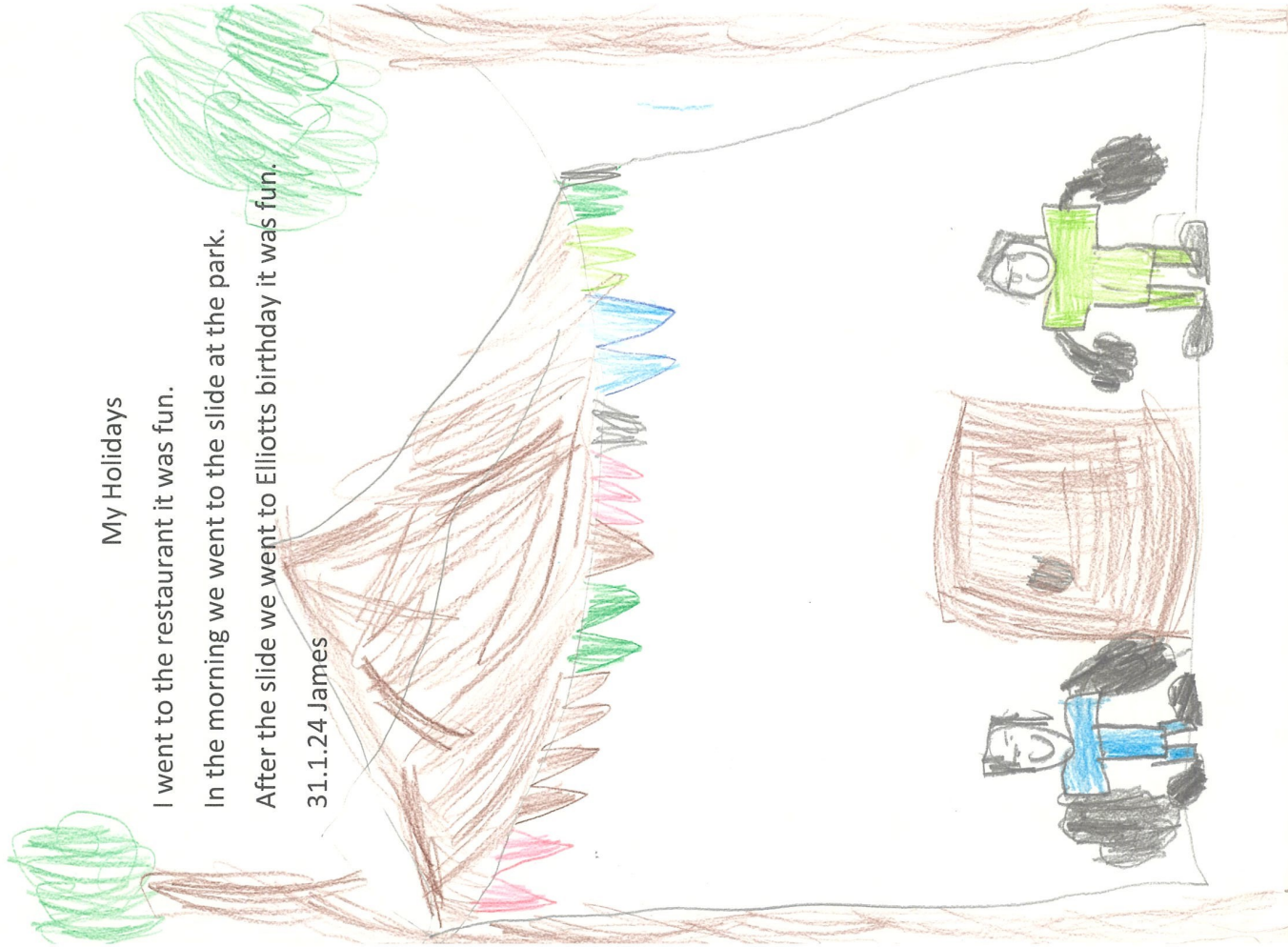

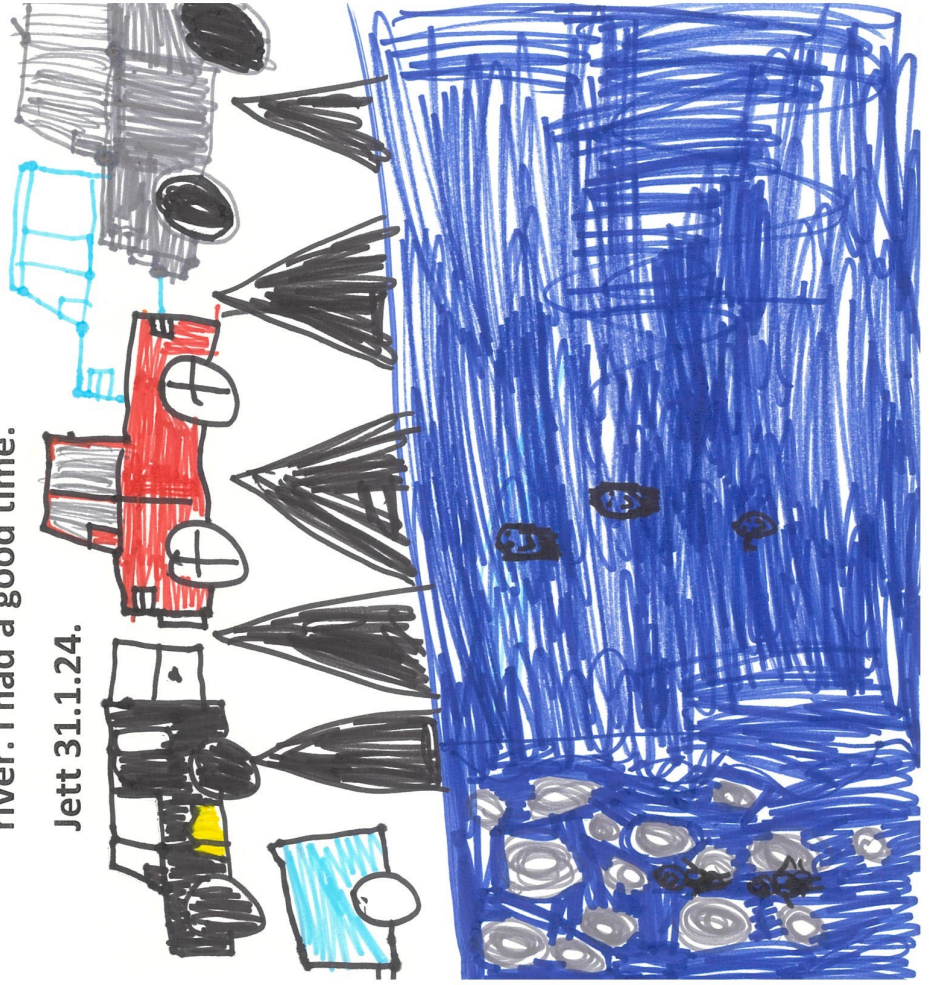

I went camping with Wyatt, Jesse, Ruby, Danielle and Charlie and we went to the river. I had a good time.

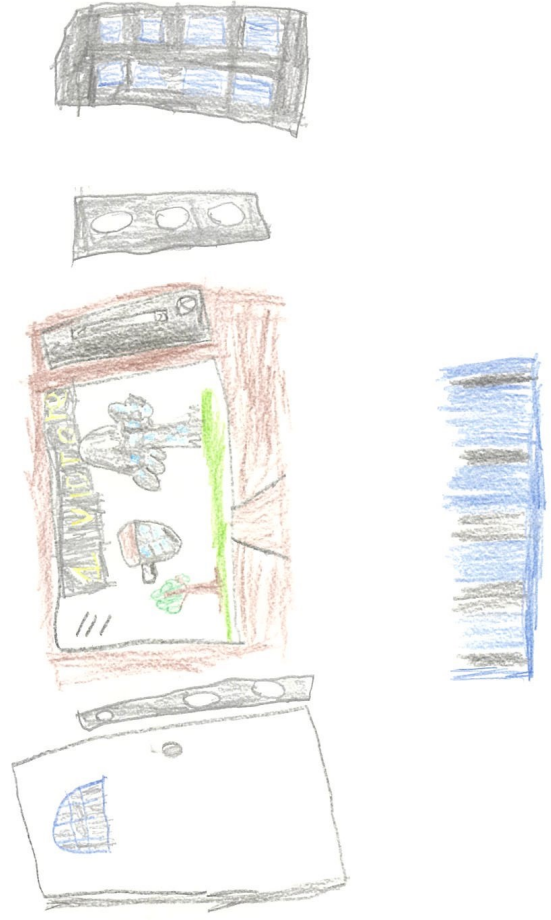
