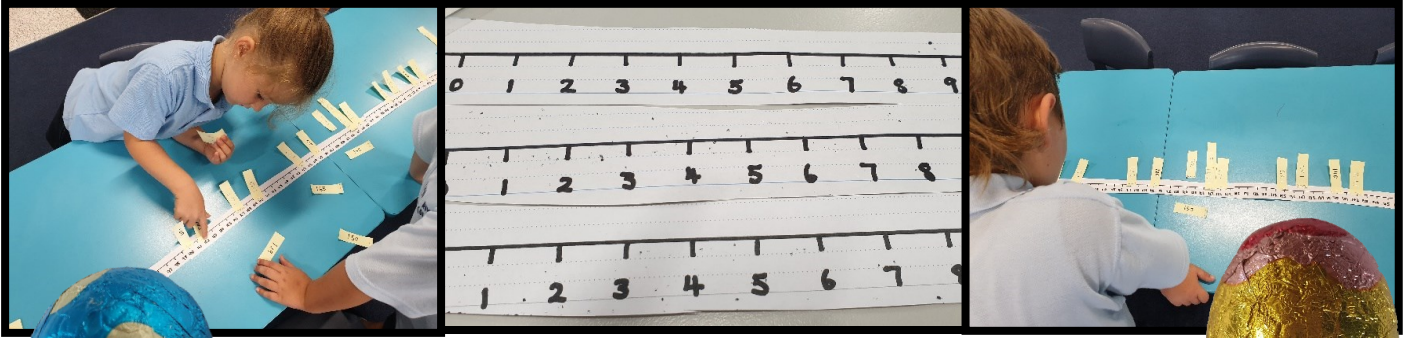

Procedural Text

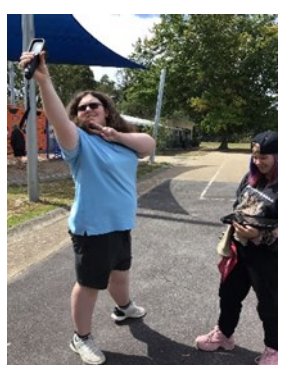
How to make an Easter Egg Guess number line

1. Show people the Easter Egg container and ask them to guess how many.
2. Fill in the units number line strips by adding the tens and hundreds.
3. Glue the number line strips in order.
4. Find where the people's guesses go on the big number line.

VCE Artmaking and Exhibiting / Media Camp

For the students of Cann River P-12 College studying the arts for VCE, the camp in Melbourne last week gave them a lot of inspiration and extended their knowledge of the world of Visual Arts and Media.

The camp enabled the students to spend a whole day visiting the National Gallery of Victoria (NGV) and the Australian Centre for the Moving Image (ACMI).

At the NGV, they explored the Triennial, where international artists presented all types of artworks from paintings to installations on the theme of Magic, Memory, and Matter. The students engaged with their learning with an NGV educator giving the students insight into the artworks and the roles of the curator, exhibition designers, and the conservators. The students showed enthusiasm and curiosity about the range of perspectives and ideas being presented.

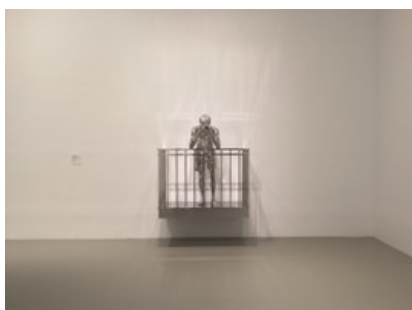
At ACMI, the students explored the history of the moving image in a comprehensive exhibition with interactive exhibits including video games and the origins of the first film projectors. The exhibition demonstrated the process of filmmaking from the pitch illustrated in storyboards, the design of sets and costumes, and the poster art.

In the other side of the gallery, the students looked around the installations of the Marshmallow Laser Feast collective. The UK group of artists, engineers, architects, and scientists created a world of nature in a discovery of the microscopic and interdimensional. The use of laser projectors allowed the audience to observe the universe and trees breathing in looped videos which were mesmerising and evocative.

The students showed their responsible and adaptive attitudes. They travelled via public transport and represented the school in a positive way. The camp will allow the VCE students to understand the objectives for their courses. Well done!


