Students explored colour, layering, and stencil techniques effectively, showing growing confidence in planning and executing a visual design. Their final skateboard artwork reflects thoughtful composition and an understanding of how surface, texture, and shape influence artistic choices. Their graffiti mural is a combination of different styles of graffiti lettering and symbols that represent each student.

One of this week's star pupil's is Macey, who started out hesitant to complete spray painting her skateboard for her art project, she held the spray can like it might explode, only agreeing to paint her skateboard after weeks of persuasion. Once the colours hit the deck and Macey saw what she could create, she was so pleased with the result and wanted to now paint her section of the class mural.

Another student showcasing her amazing artistic skill is Bella, she is the quiet achiever with a steady hand adding the final touches with acrylic paint pens to her skateboard.

We are racing to complete our graffiti mural by the end of term and hope to have another update soon of the progression of the talented years 7 to 10 visual arts students.
