The Fitt Bit.

A few weeks ago, my boss informed me of a teacher learning day with a person who has had experience and the knowledge to make small schools great.

Of course, I was sceptical as we are already outstanding, but I still listened intently to hear what they had to say. I was glad that I attended because as I listened, I visualised what a really great school would be like.

A great school is based on an 'Admiration' rather than a 'Deficit' model. I 'd never heard this explained before, but a deficit model is when you focus on the negatives and what children are doing wrong, whilst an admiration model is about looking at who they are, their achievements and building them up to fill the gaps.

An admiration model looks at what's going well, and it is all about asking the children what they think. It is looking at their growth as everything that they learn is special, recognising that children are all individuals and learn at different rates.

It's allowing the children to be curious and teachers being curious with them. Curiosity is the reason that we initially want to learn. All children should be encouraged to be curious and to follow their interests.

It is allowing the children to think, plan and form personal goals and its seeing the potential in each individual and focusing on that. Not doing well in a test has nothing to do with potential, potential is deeper, special and it is present in very child.

Its about using creative teaching strategies to inspire the children to take learning steps themselves, take risks and achieve personal satisfaction

A study that I read said that all children are really enthusiastic and curious before they reach school and by the time they get to secondary school level, many have lost the excitement associated with learning something new...they have not been allowed to be curious.

As I listened to the speaker, I had a vision in my head of Cowwarr Primary and although we can always improve, I felt quite proud.
