Phelan-McDermid Syndrome Day - October 22

On Tuesday 22nd October, our school proudly recognised Phelan-McDermid Syndrome Awareness Day by wearing green — the official colour of support and awareness for this rare genetic condition.

The day is a global effort to raise awareness for the syndrome, encourage earlier diagnosis, and support the community by sharing stories and shining a light on the strength of those affected. The colour associated with the day is green, symbolizing hope, strength, and unity.

Nick from Room 3, is one of approximately 10,000 people worldwide who have been diagnosed with Phelan-McDermid Syndrome. Nick, his mother, Katrina, Jacqueline, Nick's teacher, Karen, one of our Education Support staff members who works with Nick and our Principal team all wore green on this day to help raise awareness.






