

Principal's Report

QR Code..... This week we placed QR codes on each of our gates and main office. Parents are asked to use this code if they are planning on being on the school grounds for an extended period of time eg, more than 15mins. By now we are all familiar with using the QR code system, given it has been rolled out in so many places, therefore we felt it was timely to include our school in the program. The system will allow us to have a better way to track people coming on and off site eg trades people, visiting support workers. Given the building works we are having around the school, as well as many other visiting professionals we have come into the school throughout the week and with some people coming from outside the area, we felt it was essential to ensure we align our record keeping with other processes put in place. Visitors will also still need to sign in through the office as part of our emergency management strategy.

Return from Remote Learning..... Thank you to everyone who adapted so quickly to remote learning last week. It was great to see our students back onsite last Friday and reconnecting with each other. Staff spent time checking in with students on their wellbeing as well as establishing how much learning they were able to achieve over the 4 days. We know that these sudden changes, as well as the longer ongoing nature of Covid can effect each of us differently. Whilst we are seeing more and more students become increasingly resilient and adapt to be flexible with changes, please let us know if you are noticing any changes in your child that we may be able to provide further support.

School Assemblies..... Currently we have put our whole school assemblies on hold, for the remainder of the term, in line with current restrictions. We are hopeful that we will still be able to hold our final assembly on the last day of Term 2 but we will keep parents informed of any changes.

Parent / Teacher Meetings..... This year we will be holding our Parent / Teacher meetings in the first few weeks of Term 3. Notes will be sent home to families at the beginning of Term 3 to confirm a time.

Early Finish..... Just a reminder to all families' that school will finish Friday the 25th June at 2:15pm, for the end of Term 2. Term 3 will commence on Monday 15th July however this is a Curriculum Day for students. Staff will spend the day in teams planning for the remainder of Term 3. **Students will resume on Tuesday 13th July.**

Bridie Camm - For always speaking respectfully to her classmates and really showing her leadership to help the preps.



Visual Arts Award - Dexter Berryman - Speaking politely to guide through the straw weaving task.


Phys Ed Award - Azallia Bertram - For showing Mutual Respect in Phys Ed by listening well and speaking respectfully to others.


