Another Busy Few Weeks... Over the last few weeks, we have seen a number of activities happening around the school. I was proud of our students representing our school at Regional Athletics last week. On Friday, we have our annual Book Week celebrations, with so many of our students and staff making the effort to dress up as their favourite character, we will make our way through town to listen to different story tellers. Parents are most welcome to join the walk, leaving school at approximately 9am. Over the next few weeks, we will see more activities as Grade 3/4 have started their swimming program amongst other activities happening around the school. Staff are working hard to ensure there is a clear balance between learning key components such as literacy and numeracy and ensuring we offer a wide range of activities.

Writers Showcase... Each year, students from across East Gippsland submit their writing to be featured in a Regional Showcase. The Showcase will open at Mechanic's Hall in Lakes Entrance so please keep a look out for dates. 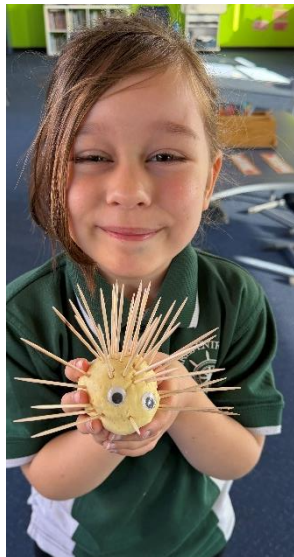


Prep in STEM

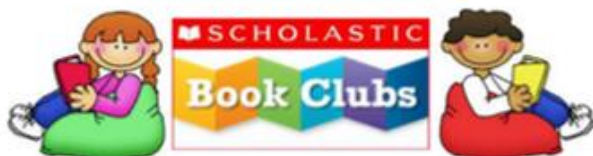

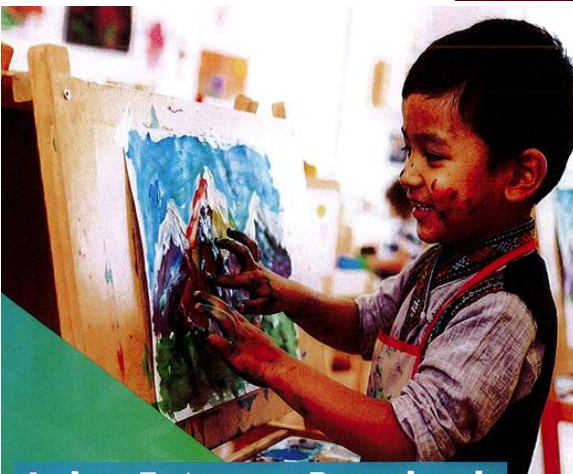
