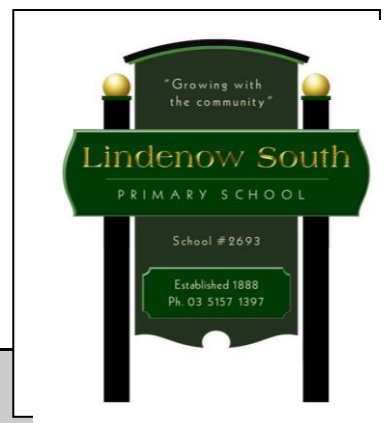

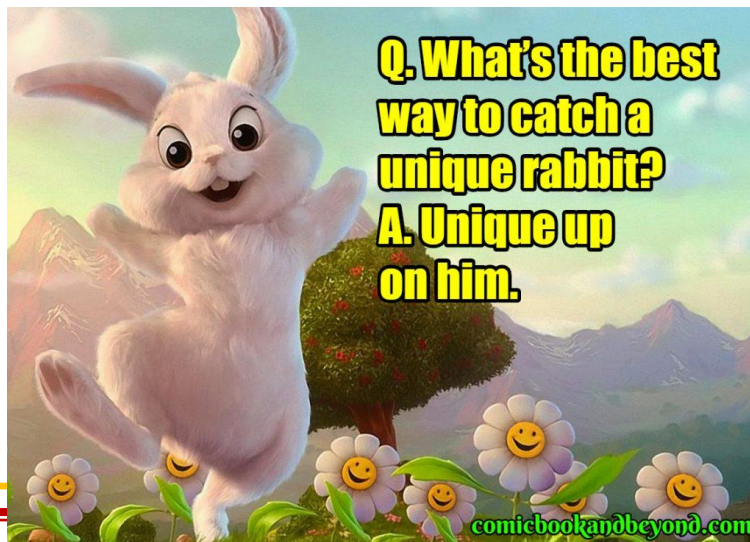
A hearty round of thanks to all parents, students, teachers and education support staff for bringing the good ship Lindenow South PS into safe harbour at the end of its first term for 2022.
