Thank you for a wonderfully warm welcome and I look forward to sharing new and exciting learning in Term 4.



## WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING ON FRIDAY'S ?






The remaining students created moving robots and coded using the program called Scratch. It is so rewarding to watch as students lead their own learning and have choices in what they do.



# Swimming



