



WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING IN OUR JUNIOR CLASSROOM?






Thank you to Samara who is the school bell ringer. We love the effort she puts in everyday.

Students are using their Writers Notebook every day and have learned the power of writing short, sharp descriptive texts by using the skill of snapshot writing.

































