Return to onsite learning for Prep to Year 2 students

Lockdown restrictions will be lifted in regional Victoria from tomorrow – Thursday at 11:59pm, following advice from Victoria’s Chief Health Officer. The five reasons to leave the home will be removed in regional Victoria, except for Greater Shepparton. There will be no limit on the distance regional Victorians can travel from home – other than restrictions on entry to metropolitan Melbourne.

For Lucknow Primary School, this means that we will reopen for onsite learning for **Prep to Grade 2 students**, while remote learning will remain for Years 3 to 6 students. Onsite supervision is available for children of essential workers in grades 3 to 6. If this is required please fill in an onsite attendance form at your earliest convenience. Please contact the office for this form.
