## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

With little over a week until the school holidays, I would again like to thank parents and carers for observing the guidelines around social distancing, drop-off and pick-up of children and restricted access to the school grounds.

Every little bit that we do, helps to keep students staff and families safe from contracting COVID-19. At this stage, we are unsure if these measures will extend into Term 3, but we will let you know as soon as we have been advised by the Department of Education. We are particularly proud of how our students have adapted to the changes in their new school routine.

As we enter the cold and flu season, we ask parents not to send children to school with coughs, colds and flu like symptoms. While it is unlikely that a student who is unwell will have COVID-19, there are precautionary steps that schools need to take to ensure the health and wellbeing of the broader school community.

If a student presents with a fever, cough or sore throat at school, parents will be contacted by phone and will need to take their child home. Students should not return until symptoms resolve.

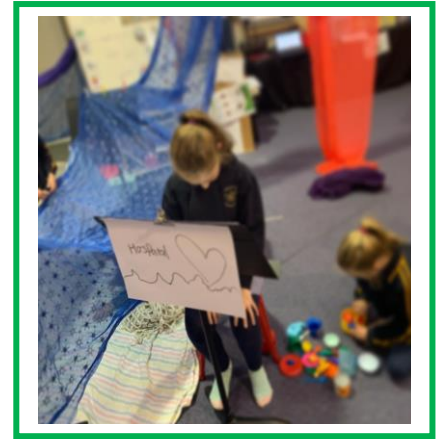
## BUSHFIRE RELIEF 2020

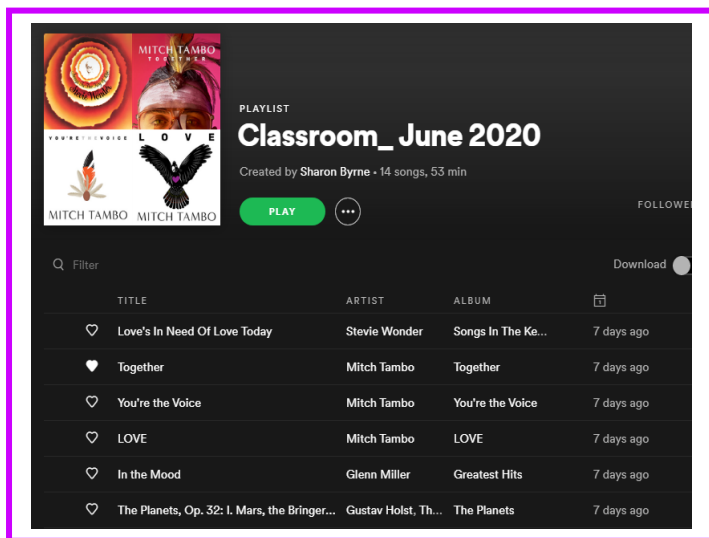
