REMINDER 2024 Parent Requests

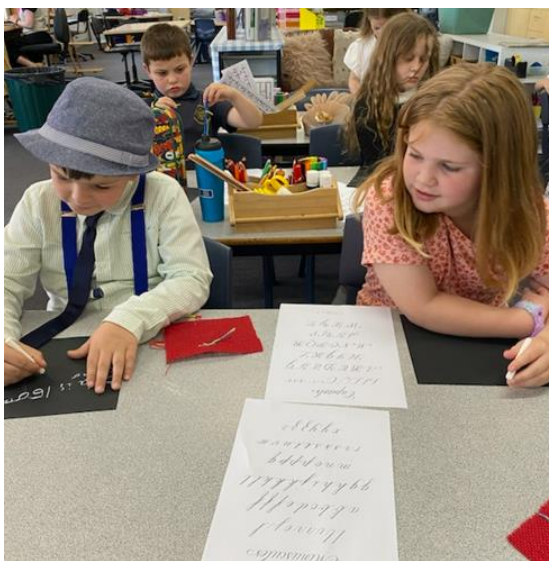
