We should soon have some concept drawings of what the preschool will look like, and I look forward to sharing these with you all through this newsletter when I am able.

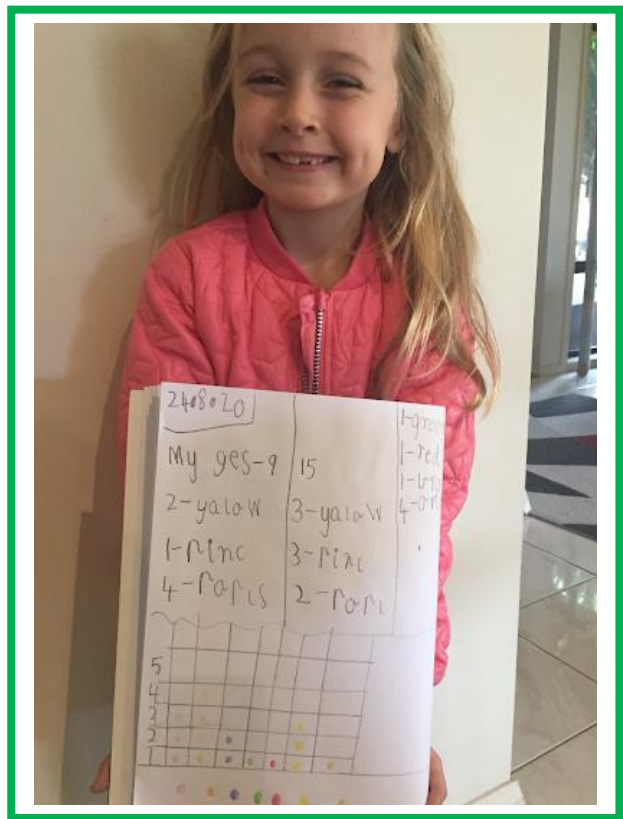
We will advise when we have more information in regards to enrolments.
