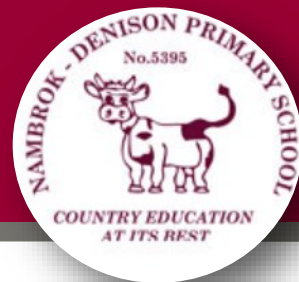

## End of day pick up

At NDPS, we have two end-of-day bells: the first rings at 3:10pm for bus travelers, and the second is our regular end-of-day bell at 3:15pm. As the car park can get quite busy during this time, we ask that parents park in front of the timber fences to leave enough room for the bus to safely move off.

Students who aren't catching the bus wait in the undercover area for their siblings before heading to the bus shelter to look for their car. To make it easier for students to spot you, we recommend waiting outside your car or coming onto the school grounds to meet them.

For safety reasons, we can only release students to their parents. If you need your child to go home with someone else, please email the teacher in advance to let them know. Additionally, please ensure your child is aware of any changes to who will be picking them up.

## Bus Travelers

Please let us know in advance if your child will not be catching the bus home, especially if there are any changes to their usual routine. We need adequate time to make sure the information is passed along to the classroom teacher and bus driver to avoid any confusion. The earlier we receive the update, the smoother the process will be for everyone.

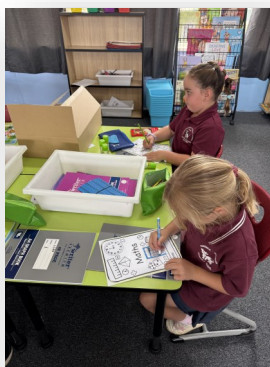

## Attendance

Please remember that as a Sun Smart School, all students must wear a wide brimmed or bucket hat when outside during recess and lunch time during Terms 1 and 4. Please ensure that your child has a proper school hat and that it is clearly named.

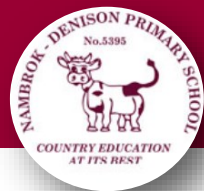
