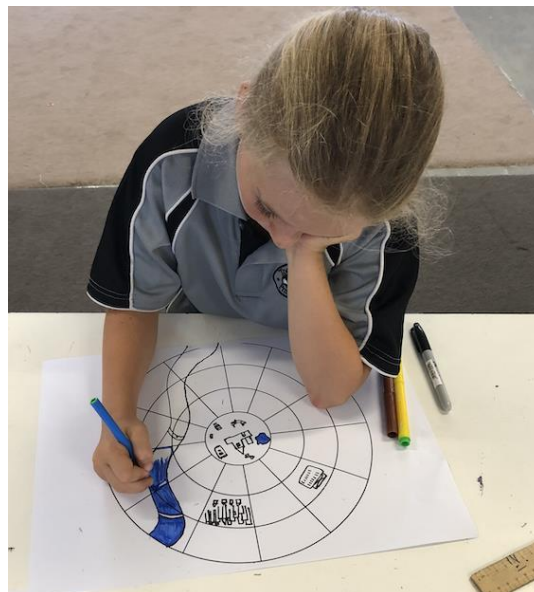
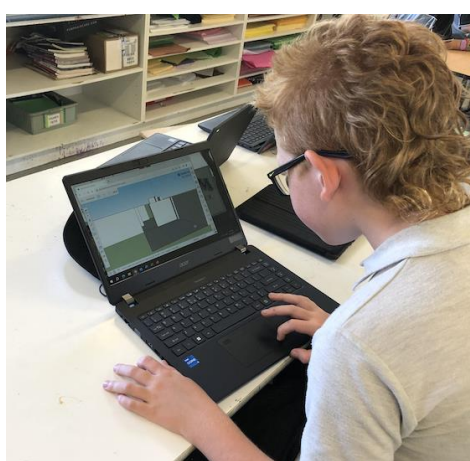
**ART**
